MANITOBA'S STRONGEST MAN IS THE NEW WPW CHAMPION

The biggest story to come out of WPW RUMBLE IN THE BURT was the crowning of a new WPW Champion, Tyler Colton. Josh "Cheeks" Holiday has had a long road in Winnipeg. After debuting at PAIN ACTUALLY in 2019, Cheeks was sidelined with a torn ACL after being driven through a table. He returned to WPW and fans were excited to see this next chapter in the young upstart's career. He was soon given an opportunity to win the IMPACT Championship when he answered Josh Alexander's open challenge. It was a hard hitting affair, one that left Holiday a more battle-tested competitor. He earned his first win in WPW when he teamed up with Red Hot Summer at GOING BROADWAY but he is still chasing his first win in singles action. At FIGHT AT THE MUSEUM, Holiday was excited to take on four other men in a Scramble match, but that wasn't in the cards. The debuting Michael Allen Richard Clark viciously attacked Cheeks on his way out to the ring, sidelining him for several months.



Cheeks made his return in THE RUMBLE IN THE BURT match and set a beeline for Clark, hitting him with a flurry of maneuvers before Clark was able to gain the upper hand and toss him out of the match, costing him a shot at the WPW Championship. Holiday hopes to get his revenge and his first singles win when he takes on Michael Allen Richard Clark at PAIN ACTUALLY RETURNS.



### A HISTORIC NIGHT FOR WPW

#### **OVER 1000 FANS ON HAND FOR RUMBLE IN THE BURT**

It was a night many WPW fans will never forget. The RUMBLE IN THE BURT, October 7th, 2023, live from the Burton Cummings Theatre. The night started off with a first time encounter between mentor and protégé as AJ Sanchez took on Chad Daniels. After a fierce back and forth, Chad Daniels proved he did learn something from Sanchez, hitting him with his patented low blow and scoring the three count. Next up we saw a trios contest which pitted two of the top wrestling schools in North America against each other, The Clandestine Society vs. The Freelancers. Ultimately the trio of Laynie Luck, GPA, and Storm Grayson picked up the win over Michael Richard Blais, Steven Crowe, and Taryn From Accounting. Fans were then treated to an incredible match between NXT UK star Amir Jordan and 'The Real Deal' James Roth. Roth continued his 2023 undefeated streak and put away the British star. The WPW Tag Team Championship was on the line when Champions Red Hot Summer defended against social media sensation The Voros Twins. The Voros Twins can't remember who painted the Mona Lisa after the beating they took at the hands of the Boys of Summer. WPW Women's Champion Jody Threat faced her biggest challenge yet, in the form of wrestling legend LuFisto. After a battle that saw them fighting all over the Burton Cummings Theatre, Jody was able to put away her rival and retain her title.









THE RUMBLE IN THE BURT match had 15 men vying for the chance to fight for the WPW Championship at PAIN ACTUALLY RETURNS. The Rumble match featured an incredible line-up of WPW favourites and debuting stars. YTV's PJ Fresh Phil hit his first ever Canadian Destroyer, we saw the emergence of a new tag team, Australian Takeover, and it took five men to topple the monstrous O'Doyle. Mo Jabari and Zicky Dice kicked things off and were also the last two men in the match. After half an hour, Mo Jabari ended up being the last man standing and earning his shot at the WPW Championship. Seleziya Sparx then took on the undefeated Ava Lawless. Sparx gained the upper hand and choked out the Hellion and earned herself a future WPW Women's Championship match.

The main event of the evening was a WPW Championship match between Champion Bobby Schink and challenger Tyler Colton. Bobby started off with an intensity not yet seen by WPW fans, hammering the Canadian Hercules with a barrage of fists. Both men kicked out of each others signature maneuvers, Bobby's top rope leg drop and Tyler's powerbomb. It took a massive powerbomb from the top rope to put Schink away and Tyler Colton was crowned the undisputed WPW Champion. It was a historic night for Winnipeg Professional Wrestling, in a venue that has seen its fair share of historical wrestling, dating back over 100 years ago. We surely haven't seen the last of WPW in the Burt!




