WPW Women's Champion has the crowd in the palm of her hands. Every time she enters, the crowd follows her every move, from her favourite maneuver, the F-416, or when she jumps into the crowd and grabs a cold Half Pints.

Jody Threat first debuted at WPW SHERB TIMES A CHARM in 2019 when she competed against Shotzi Blackheart in a triple threat match. Since then, Jody has traveled all over North America honing her craft and developing new ways to inflict punishment. Jody returned in December 2019 and defeated Alexia Nicole at WPW PAIN ACTUALLY (available on WPW DVD) and cemented herself at the top of WPW's Women's Division.

The Wild Child issued an open challenge at WPW OH BEHAVE and it was answered by none other than Allie Katch. Unfortunately for Jody, she wasn't able to pick up the win but it helped her refocus on her desire to the be the top competitor in WPW Women's Division.



The WPW Women's Championship was introduced at WPW DON'T TELL MOM THE REFEREE'S DEAD and pitted Jody Threat and Allie Katch against each other for the honour of being the first champion. It was a hard hitting contest that saw both women brawl all over the West End Cultural Centre, but in the end Jody Threat came out as the first WPW Women's Champion and settled their score in WPW.

Since winning the championship the Wild Child has been on an incredible winning streak. In December at WPW PAIN ACTUALLY 2, Threat scored a win in the main event over Blair Onyx. This was followed up in January at WPW COLD OUT with not one but two title defenses in one night. Jody defeated Masha Slamovich in one of the greatest matches in WPW history; a 20 minute brutal affair that left both women reeling, and then answered an open • challenge later in the night from Tootie Lynn. The Champ then defended the title against Laynie Luck in March <mark>and</mark> in the main event of WPW FIGHT AT THE MUSEUM against Seleyiza Sparx in front of over 500 screaming fans.

Over and over, Jody Threat has proven herself as one of the toughest and most talented competitors in WPW and this spring signed a contract with IMPACT Wrestling. Maybe we'll be seeing some Knockout Championship gold to go along with the WPW Women's Championship sitting on her mantle!

The tandem of Bryce Bentley and Sammy Peppers have been on quite the roll since debuting in WPW in 2022. Sammy Peppers was well known to WPW fans for several years, debuting at the second WPW event, BARRCADE, in February 2019. Unfortunately he would go 0-4, picking up losses in a Half Pints Six Pack Challenge and three singles matches

Fans could see a lot of potential in Peppers but that just wasn't translating into wins on the big stage. But things changed when WPW returned from the COVID-19 pandemic. In April 2022, WPW LOOK WHO'S WRESTLING finally saw the team of Peppers and Bentley join forces as Red Hot Summer and pick up the win, the first win for Peppers in WPW.





Things were heating up for Red Hot Summer, as they picked up several victories and were riding high, until they were faced with Technical Difficulties. At WPW PAIN ACTUALLY 2, Red Hot Summer lost for for the first time, some say due to not taking their opponents seriously and focusing more on having a "good time". In their rematch in January, Red Hot Summer refocused and settled the score with their now bitter rivals Technical Difficulties. They might like to dance and have a good time but Red Hot Summer know when to turn the temperature up and put things into full gear.

On May 12th at WPW TRUE VIOLENCE, Bentley and Peppers will battle Technical Difficulties to become the first WPW Tag Team Champions. Will Red Hot Summer cement themselves at the top of the WPW Tag Team Division or will Rahim De La Suede and Moses the Deliver help them experience Technical Difficulties?























CARD SUBJECT TO CHANGE





Tyler Colton has finally returned to Winnipeg Professional Wrestling and his victory at FIGHT AT THE MUSEUM was just the beginning.

When Tyler returned to confront longtime rival AJ Sanchez at WPW ONCE UPON A TIME, The Canadian Hercules made his intentions clear: he wasn't here for Championship gold, he was here to settle old scores and cement himself as one of the greatest wrestlers in Winnipeg Pro Wrestling history.

Tyler Colton's winning ways go all the way back to the very first WPW event, SHERB YOUR ENTHUSIASM, where he defeated Ethan Page in a singles bout. At the very next event, BARRCADE, Colton picked up the win against Canadian wrestling legend Tyson Dux.



In the fall of 2019, The Canadian Hercules became embroiled in a feud with AJ Sanchez. Both men were looking to sit alone at the top of WPW and neither was willing to give an inch.

The abuse of General Manager James Korba at the hands of AJ Sanchez is we documented, and Tyler Colton was often caught in the middle. After being physically accosted while playing VLTs, James Korba put Sanchez in a tag team match against The North for the IMPACT Tag Team Titles and made longtime enemy Tyler Colton his partner, as a not-so-subtle jab to Sanchez.

Colton and Sanchez were not victorious, and after the match Colton was to victim of a vicious beatdown at the hands of AJ Sanchez. This bitter feur let to the creation of the WPW Championship, where GM Korba had to count the 3 for AJ Sanchez. This was the last we saw of Tyler Colton for almost for years. But now, The Canadian Hercules is back to stack up bodies and take back WPW for good!

THE LAST TEMPTATION OF CURTIS

"THE JACKED JESUS" HAS HIS SIGHTS SET ON THE WPW CHAMPIONSHIP

"The Jacked Jesus" Tommy Lee Curtis made his WPW debut on Good Friday 2022, and so far no other WPW competitor has been able to nail him down. Undefeated in singles action, TLC has defeated fan favourites like James Roth, Mo Jabari, Devon Monroe and even current WPW Champion Bobby Schink. What has been the key to Curtis' incredible success?

Some would say it's his impressive physique, but many are saying it's his willingness to break the rules and take things to the next level. In each of these matches, Tommy Lee Curtis has taken his patented resistance bands and wrapped them around the neck of his competitors, squeezing and flexing until they simply cannot breathe.

However, things came to a head at WPW ONCE UPON A TIME IN WINNIPEG in March when after his victory against Josh "Cheeks" Holiday, TLC grabbed his holy resistance bands and went to choke out the young upstart. Referee Alfonso Galliano tried to intervene, but found himself laying on the ground with the bands wrapped around his neck, gasping for air and seeing the light.

Other referees and WPW security entered the ring and eventually stopped the egregious assault, but the damage had been done. Referee Alfonso Galliano underwent emergency throat rehabilitation and has been struggling to speak since the incident. This was horrible timing for Tommy Lee Curtis, as he had just won a #1 contenders match at WPW COLD OUT. Fed up with the constant attacks from WPW talent, the referees petitioned WPW General Manager James Korba to take action.

"The Jacked Jesus" was suspended for one month and lost his shot at the title at FIGHT AT THE MUSEUM. His suspension is now over and Tommy Lee Curtis looks to defeat "Sweet" Bobby Schink and become the third WPW Champion at WPW TRUE VIOLENCE! Will "The Jacked Jesus" have his trusty resistance bands in tow?
